Seal of multilingual proficiency	I	Olivas	<p>Updates: 1) For seniors only, 2) Must have taken 1 year of target language during High School Career</p> <p>M/ Updates are given to parents even if they do not have children in High School, they will affect their children once they do reach the grade level to participate. Only Seniors will be able to take the Seal of Multilingual test. The state needs the student's ESBAC results from 11th grade. Starting the new school year, the HS principal stated that whoever wants to do the multilingual seal needs to have taken a Spanish course for one year minimum. AP Classes are college credit classes because students are advanced.</p>

ELPAC	I	Olivas	<p>Update: 1) Reclassification Guidelines from CDE; 2) Status of reclassification requirements set by the District.</p> <p>M/ When parents register their kids in school, there is a question of what language the child first spoke at home. If it is Spanish they will be taking the ELPAC test to make sure that they have grasped the English Language. Since it is a new test they decided to reclassify the students and the test will determine their English Language capability. They can get extra help to classify them as English. The teacher can also assist and have a meeting with parents to let them know that there is some need in English. If student does not speak any English, they will take child apart and work with them individually. Maybe they do speak good English minimally but they might need more instruction in English. In the dual immersion program students do not get the extra help because English is taught as a second language. Mrs. Olivas showed an example of ELPAC scoring to all parents. The goal is to have do the reclassification by November so we can celebrate in December. Parents will be notified if kids will be reclassified. Mrs. Olivas explained the additional nationalities that include the Spanish language. It includes 19 countries and 2 European countries that speak Spanish. Ex: Guatemala/Honduras/Argentina. The rules of writing are all the same for the Spanish language.</p>
