PROGRAM DESCRIPTION / DETAILS:

All credit based classes taken in the 7th-12th grade reflect on the transcripts and allow students to receive high school graduation and A-G course credit. Examples of these classes and credits may look like Spanish 1 in 8th grade for 5 credits per semester or Integrated Math 1 for 5 credits per semester for passing grade earned.

RECOMMENDED ACTION:

The Director of Secondary Education and Denair Middle School Interim Principal recommends to approve the BTF for all 7th-12th grade students to receive the appropriate credits for classes taken offered at the high school level.
